COUNCIL MINUTES – May 6, 2019

The Town Council of the Town of Steele, Alabama, met in Regular Session at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, May 6, 2019 at Steele Town Hall. Upon roll call the following members were present:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Adams, who asked Councilmember Gleason Jr. to lead everyone in a word of prayer.

The Town Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on Monday, April 15, 2019, motion was made by Councilmember Barnes to approve the minutes, 2nd Councilmember Gleason Jr. and approved by the Town Council.

The Town Council having read the minutes from the Special Called Meeting held on Tuesday, April 30, 2019, motion was made by Councilmember Barnes to approve the minutes, 2nd Councilmember Reynolds and approved by the Town Council, with Miller-Borg abstaining.

The Town Council having reviewed the March financial reports, motion was made by Councilmember Reynolds approving the financial reports, 2nd Councilmember Gleason Jr. and approved by the Town Council.

Mayor Adams requested the Town Council to review the April financial reports and approve at the next Council Meeting.

Mayor Adams informed the Town Council that the stall dividers and hand dryers will be installed in the restrooms at the sports complex this week.

Mayor Adams presented Resolution 2019-002 that the State of Alabama Community Development Block Grant Program has been established to assist communities in meeting community development needs consistent objectives as set forth in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The Town of Steele is in compliance with the State of Alabama, ADECA/HUD regulations, and the following documents are hereby a part of the Town of Steele's procedures for implementing a CDBG project;

1. Grievance Procedure - for individuals believing they are a victim of discrimination because of a disability and will become a part of the Town's Personnel Policies.

2. 504 Self Evaluation/Transition Plan (all facilities must be accessible to the handicapped) and supersedes one adopted February, 2014.

Motion was made by Councilmember Gleason Jr. adopting and approving Resolution 2019-002, 2nd Councilmember Miller-Borg and approved by the Town Council.

Mayor Adams informed the Town Council that the security cameras will be installed next week. The playground equipment will begin installation the middle of June.

Councilmember Gleason Jr. stated that there is a water hose and brass nozzle missing from the storage room at the sports complex restrooms.

Councilmember Barnes stated that he will be participating in the Career Day at Ashville Middle School on Tuesday, May 7, 2019.

Councilmember Miller-Borg stated that the Amazing Race was very successful and thanked those who participated.

Librarian Lynda Fann informed the Town Council that the summer reading program will begin on Thursday, June 6th. The library will have four different shows this year. Fann would also like to change the Library hours to 7.5 hours a day, Monday-Thursday 9:00 am - 4:30 pm for the summer.

The Town Council all agreed it was acceptable.

Martha Stewart, the Water Board Chairman, stated that everything is going very well with the Water Board.

With there being no further business to come before this Regular Council Meeting of May 6, 2019, Councilmember Miller-Borg made a motion to adjourn the meeting, 2nd Councilmember Barnes, adjourned at 6:50 p.m..
